

Recently completed a course at Cambridge?

Your Tier 4 BRP shows our Sponsor Licence Number (4NUV7KB58) but is attached to your previous course. In accordance with Tier 4 policy, you are allowed to start your new course as long as you submit your new Tier 4 application within six weeks or before you current visa expires, whichever is earlier.

Before 12th November 2019 or before you current visa expires (whichever is earlier) you must:

1. Submit your new Tier 4 application online using the CAS you have received from Cambridge
2. Provide one of the following:
 - Completed visa application form; or
 - 'Document Checklist'

You can obtain this from the UK Visas and Immigration system once you have applied. This shows the date and type of application and confirms that you have paid the application fee.

You should bring these documents to your College or send it by email. We **cannot** accept the confirmation email you will receive from UKVI.

It is advisable to apply as soon as you are ready. The decision timeframe for a Tier 4 application in the UK using the standard service is 8 weeks. After a decision is made, your new BRP will be sent to you by courier. In accordance with Tier 4 policy, you cannot travel outside the Common Travel Area (UK and Ireland) once you have applied until you have received your new BRP.

Recently completed a course at a different institution?

Your Tier 4 BRP is attached to your previous institution and cannot be used to study at Cambridge. A BRP issued for Cambridge would include the University's sponsor licence number (4NUV7KB58).

Before you start your course you must:

1. Submit a new Tier 4 application online using the CAS you have received from Cambridge.
2. Provide one of the following:
 - Completed visa application form; or
 - 'Document Checklist'

You can obtain this from the UK Visas and Immigration system once you have applied. This shows the date and type of application and confirms that you have paid the application fee.

You should bring these documents to your College or send it by email. We cannot accept the confirmation email you will receive from UKVI.

You cannot matriculate or commence your studies at Cambridge until you have provided this evidence.

When you receive your new BRP you will need to bring this to your College for scanning as soon as possible.
