Finding and borrowing books from Wolfson College Library

To search for a book use iDiscover. This will tell you the shelf mark. The first part of the number tells you which shelf it's on. Then look at the spine of the book for the rest of the number.

If you're on a taught course, you may have an online reading list. Click on the title of a book to see which libraries it's available in. Not all copies are listed so 'View Online' and then within iDiscover, 'See all versions' that are available. Even then you may wish to conduct a title search to find the book you're looking for.

To borrow a book use the self-issue machine. Place your card under the red light and follow the instructions on the screen.

You can borrow up to 20 books which are renewed automatically. If you need a book that's on loan, request it on iDiscover. Recalled books must be returned within three days.

To return a book, pop it through the slot in the foyer. To find out more about getting the resources you need for your research, look at the Wolfson LibGuide.
