Welcome to Wolfson College Library. Please note that we have separate entry and exit doors. Entry is to the right of the clock tower.

We politely remind you to socially distance in the library and wear a face covering in line with college guidance.

We're open 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

The book return box is in the foyer.

You'll need your Cambridge card to enter all the rooms. You'll also need your card to exit the upstairs reading room.

There is a limit on the number of people who are allowed in a room at one time. Please check when you enter.

There are surface wipes and hand sanitizer in all rooms.

On the ground floor is the Sir David Williams room with a range of study spaces.

The college computer room is opposite, with printers and photocopiers.

Please use the one-way system in operation on the stairs.

The main reading room is upstairs; please let us know if you need to use the lift.

Our study spaces are equipped with power points and lamps. We also offer earplugs book stands lumbar supports and fans to make it more comfortable. We recommend you bring an extra jumper or blanket as we'll have to keep the windows open.

Please don't move chairs around as they've been deliberately distanced.

If you're leaving your desk please fill in a pink form to let us know that you'll be back within the hour. If you'll be longer than an hour please take your belongings with you or leave them on the allocated shelves.

As this is a quiet study of space please keep your phone on silent and make calls outside the library.

You can have drinks and cold food at your desk. There's a fridge and coffee machine in the basement along with toilets and lockers.
